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10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to public finance; establishing the
12 Oklahoma State Government Business Licensing One-Stop
13 Program; imposing duties on the Chief Information
14 Officer; requiring certain savings; requiring
15 reduction of certain fees; providing for real-time
16 licensing; making transfer from the Oklahoma
17 Department of Commerce to the Office of State
18 Finance; authorizing certain exemptions; requiring
19 agency compliance; providing for codification;
20 providing an effective date; and declaring an
21 emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.11.9 of Title 62, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 A. There is hereby established the Oklahoma State Government
2 Business Licensing One-Stop Program.

3 B. The Chief Information Officer shall promulgate procedures by
4 which state agencies shall enter into an arrangement with the Office
5 of State Finance for the provision of a real-time licensing and
6 permitting one-stop web-based offering.

7 C. Real-time licensing and permitting services shall be made
8 available to the public through the website "Business.ok.gov" and
9 shall be offered through the 2nd Century Entrepreneurship Center
10 business licensing framework.

11 D. The 2nd Century Entrepreneurship Center and all
12 corresponding assets and personnel are hereby transferred from the
13 Oklahoma Department of Commerce to the Information Services Division
14 of the Office of State Finance.

15 E. The Chief Information Officer may grant an exemption from
16 the requirements of this section to state agencies which offer
17 licensing and permitting procedures requiring documentation that
18 cannot be provided through a web-based portal.

19 F. State agencies shall comply with procedures promulgated
20 pursuant to the terms of this section.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
