

13 An Act relating to firearms; authorizing certain  
14 state officials to carry firearms under certain  
15 circumstances; providing for codification; and  
16 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.30 of Title 21, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The Attorney General or any Assistant Attorney General may carry  
23 a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the State of Oklahoma,  
24 except while off-duty on private property if prohibited by the owner

1 or occupant of the private property. In order to carry a firearm,  
2 the Attorney General or Assistant Attorney General must successfully  
3 complete an approved course of firearm training conducted by a  
4 certified firearms instructor which is equal to the minimum  
5 requirements for firearms training as set forth by the Council on  
6 Law Enforcement Education and Training.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
