12 An Act relating to public health and safety; creating
13 the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training Program Act;
14 defining terms; creating the Oklahoma Hospital
15 Residency Training Program; establishing purpose of
16 the Program; requiring Oklahoma Health Care Authority
17 to designate certain hospitals; authorizing Authority
18 to contract with certain colleges to provide certain
19 funding; requiring Authority to provide technical
20 assistance and funding to certain colleges, to
21 establish certain reporting mechanisms, and to
22 present certain report to certain individuals;
23 creating the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training
24 Program Revolving Fund; providing for codification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 697.22 of Title 70, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma
2 Hospital Residency Training Program Act".

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 697.23 of Title 70, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 As used in the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training Program Act:

7 1. "Eligible hospital" means a hospital which qualifies for new
8 residency training programs under the rules established by the
9 Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services or other federal entities
10 authorized to establish residency training programs;

11 2. "Residency training program" means post-medical-school
12 graduate training programs approved by the Centers for Medicare and
13 Medicaid Services and accredited by the appropriate governing bodies
14 of either the osteopathic or allopathic professions in the training
15 disciplines of family medicine, general internal medicine, general
16 pediatrics, and obstetrics/gynecology and emergency medicine; and

17 3. "Medically underserved areas" means areas having too few
18 primary care providers, high infant mortality, high poverty, a high
19 elderly population, and/or a population census of at least fifty
20 percent (50%) Medicare, Medicaid and uninsured mix.

21 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 697.24 of Title 70, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

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1 A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Hospital Residency
2 Training Program to be administered by the Oklahoma Health Care
3 Authority.

4 B. The purpose of the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training
5 Program shall be to establish new residency training programs
6 affiliated with the Oklahoma State University College of Osteopathic
7 Medicine and the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine in
8 eligible hospitals, focused on meeting the healthcare needs of
9 medically underserved areas, subject to the availability of funding.

10 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 697.25 of Title 70, unless there
12 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall, in consultation
14 with the Oklahoma State University College of Osteopathic Medicine
15 and the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine, designate
16 eligible hospitals for the creation of new residency training
17 programs to serve medically underserved areas.

18 B. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority is authorized to contract
19 with the Oklahoma State University of Osteopathic Medicine and the
20 University of Oklahoma College of Medicine to provide funding for
21 the establishment of new residency training programs created under
22 the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training Program Act.

23 C. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall, with the
24 assistance of the Oklahoma State University College of Osteopathic

1 Medicine and the University of Oklahoma College of Medicine, provide
2 technical assistance and funding for the colleges' costs incurred in
3 supporting the programs to ensure that residency training programs
4 established pursuant to the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training
5 Program Act become funded by the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare
6 Services.

7 D. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall establish reporting
8 mechanisms for eligible hospitals for the monitoring of progress of
9 the new residency training programs.

10 E. The Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall present a report on
11 the operation of the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training Program to
12 the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the
13 Speaker of the House of Representatives within one (1) month of the
14 beginning of each regular session of the Legislature which shall
15 include, but shall not be limited to, information on the progress
16 made in implementing the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training
17 Program Act.

18 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 697.26 of Title 70, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
22 for the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to be designated the
23 "Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training Program Revolving Fund". The
24 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year

1 limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the
2 Oklahoma Health Care Authority from state funds, federal funds,
3 grants, contracts, and private gifts or bequests dedicated to or for
4 the Oklahoma Hospital Residency Training Program. All monies
5 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
6 be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Health Care Authority for
7 the purpose of administering the Oklahoma Hospital Residency
8 Training Program. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon
9 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
10 prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of State Finance
11 for approval and payment.

12 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

13 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
