11 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
12 to refer to the people for their approval or
13 rejection the repeal of Sections 2, 3 and 4 of
14 Article XXV of the Constitution of the State of
15 Oklahoma and a proposed amendment to the Constitution
16 of the State of Oklahoma adding a new section to
17 Article XXV to be designated as Section 6; providing
18 for the creation of a department to administer human
19 services for the people; providing ballot title; and
20 directing filing.

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23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
24 2ND SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
the repeal of Sections 2, 3 and 4 of Article XXV of the Constitution
of the State of Oklahoma which relate to the Oklahoma Public Welfare
Commission and the Director of Public Welfare.

1 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
2 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
3 the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
4 Oklahoma by adding a new Section 6 to Article XXV thereof, to read
5 as follows:

6 Section 6. For the purpose of effectively administering and
7 carrying into execution all laws enacted pursuant to the authority
8 granted in Section 1 of this Article, the Legislature is hereby
9 authorized to create a department or departments charged with the
10 duty and responsibility of faithfully administering and carrying
11 into execution all laws enacted pursuant to the authority granted in
12 Section 1 of this Article and shall perform such other duties as
13 may, from time to time, be prescribed by law.

14 SECTION 3. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
15 amendment as set forth in SECTIONS 1 and 2 of this resolution shall
16 be in the following form:

19 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

20 This measure amends the State Constitution. It provides for the
21 repeal of Sections 2, 3 and 4 of Article 25 which relate to the
22 Department of Public Welfare, the Oklahoma Public Welfare
23 Commission and the Director of Public Welfare. This measure
24 grants the Legislature the authority to create and direct by law

1 the administration of a department or departments to provide for
2 public welfare for the people of the State of Oklahoma.

6 SECTION 4. The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives,
