together with Engrossed House Amendments thereto, beg leave to report that we have had the same under consideration and herewith return the same with the following recommendations:





10 An Act relating to dedication of memorial highways
11 and bridges; designating the Sergeant Schuyler B.
12 Patch Memorial Highway; designating the Sergeant
13 Andrew R. Looney Memorial Highway; designating the
14 Specialist Christopher D. Horton Memorial Highway;
15 designating the Sgt. Anthony Del Mar Peterson
16 Memorial Highway; designating the Captain David "JP"
17 Thompson Memorial Highway; designating the Sergeant
18 Bucky Eisenberger Memorial Highway; designating the
19 Pamela Cleveland Argo Memorial Bridge; designating
20 the Specialist Jordan Morris Memorial Highway;
21 designating the Arthur and Gladys Baker Memorial
22 Bridge; designating the Sergeant Vincent L. C. Owens
23 Memorial Bridge; designating the Chappelle Family
24 Memorial Highway; designating the Lt. Colonel Warren
Pingleton Memorial Bridge; designating the Major Bill
Morgan Memorial Bridge; designating the Ronnie
Sumpter, Sonny Harris and Rhonda Howard Memorial
Bridge; designating the Specialist Micheal Phillips
Memorial Highway; designating the Aaron Harrison
Scott Memorial Bridge; designating the Corporal Jared
Shoemaker Memorial Bridge; designating the Braggs
Veterans Memorial Highway; designating the 1LT David
Timothy Wright II Memorial Highway; requiring certain
permanent markers; providing for codification;
providing an effective date; and declaring an
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.117 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 86th Street North to 96th
5 Street North shall be designated as the "Sergeant Schuyler B. Patch
6 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
7 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
8 name.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.118 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 96th Street North to 106th
13 Street North shall be designated as the "Sergeant Andrew R. Looney
14 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
15 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
16 name.

17 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.119 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 106th Street North to 116th
21 Street North shall be designated as the "Specialist Christopher D.
22 Horton Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
23 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
24 that name.

1 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.120 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 76th Street North to 86th
5 Street North shall be designated as the "Sgt. Anthony Del Mar
6 Peterson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
7 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
8 that name.

9 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.121 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The section of U.S. Highway 64 from Hooker, Oklahoma, extending
13 east to Turpin, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Captain David
14 "JP" Thompson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
15 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway
16 bearing that name.

17 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.122 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of highway from the junction of State Highway 99 and
21 State Highway 11 extending south to the Wynona municipal limits
22 shall be designated as the "Sergeant Bucky Eisenberger Memorial
23 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
24 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.123 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over the Canadian River on State Highway 2 north of
5 Whitefield, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Pamela Cleveland
6 Argo Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
7 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
8 bridge.

9 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.124 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The section of highway from the junction of State Highway 108
13 and State Highway 51 extending south to the Ripley municipal limits
14 shall be designated as the "Specialist Jordan Morris Memorial
15 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
16 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

17 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.125 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The bridge over Big Lee Creek on State Highway 101 southwest of
21 Short shall be designated as the "Arthur and Gladys Baker Memorial
22 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
23 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.126 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over the Poteau River on State Highway 9 west of
5 Pocola shall be designated as the "Sergeant Vincent L. C. Owens
6 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
7 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
8 bridge.

9 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.127 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The section of State Highway 75 from Interstate 244 north to
13 56th Street North within the Tulsa municipal limits shall be
14 designated as the "Chappelle Family Memorial Highway". The
15 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
16 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

17 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.128 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The bridge over Brushy Creek on State Highway 63 southwest of
21 Haileyville shall be designated as the "Lt. Colonel Warren Pingleton
22 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
23 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
24 bridge.

1 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.129 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Brushy Creek on U.S. Highway 270 northwest of
5 Haileyville shall be designated as the "Major Bill Morgan Memorial
6 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
7 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

8 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.130 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The bridge over the Little Fourche Maline Creek on U.S. Highway
12 270 east of the municipal limits of Panola shall be designated as
13 the "Ronnie Sumpter, Sonny Harris and Rhonda Howard Memorial
14 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
15 permanent markers bearing those names to be placed on the bridge.

16 SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.131 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The section of Interstate 35 beginning at the northern municipal
20 limit of Ardmore and extending to the southern municipal limit of
21 Ardmore shall be designated as the "Specialist Micheal Phillips
22 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
23 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
24 name.

1 SECTION 16. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.132 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over the Kiamichi River on U.S. Highway 271 located
5 one (1) mile south of the municipal limits of Clayton shall be
6 designated as the "Aaron Harrison Scott Memorial Bridge". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

9 SECTION 17. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.133 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The bridge over East 81st Street on U.S. Highway 169 within the
13 municipal limits of Tulsa shall be designated as the "Corporal Jared
14 Shoemaker Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
15 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
16 the bridge.

17 SECTION 18. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.134 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of State Highway 10 beginning one (1) mile north of
21 the municipal limits of Braggs and extending one (1) mile south past
22 the southern municipal boundary of Braggs shall be designated as the
23 "Braggs Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of
24

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
2 on the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 19. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.135 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The two-mile section of State Highway 37 in Moore, Oklahoma,
7 from the junction of State Highway 37 and Eastern Avenue extending
8 east to the junction of State Highway 37 and Sunnyslane Road shall be
9 designated as the "1LT David Timothy Wright II Memorial Highway".
10 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
11 markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

12 SECTION 20. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

13 SECTION 21. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
