10 CONFERENCE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11 An Act relating to driver licenses; creating the  
12 Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Act; providing  
13 short title; providing method for making certain  
14 voluntary contribution; stating method for crediting  
15 certain contributions; requiring the Department of  
16 Public Safety or motor license agents to make certain  
17 inquiry; providing for administration costs; creating  
18 the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund;  
19 providing type of fund; stating source of funds;  
20 providing for expenditure of funds; providing for  
21 codification; providing for noncodification; and  
22 providing an effective date.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma  
Bicycle Safety Awareness Act".

1           SECTION 2.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-124 of Title 47, unless there  
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4           A. An applicant for an original or replacement driver license  
5 or identification card shall be given an opportunity to make a  
6 voluntary contribution of Five Dollars (\$5.00) to be credited to the  
7 Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund established in  
8 Section 3 of this act. Any voluntary contribution shall be added to  
9 the driver license or identification card fee or fees as provided by  
10 law and then be referred to the State Treasurer and credited to the  
11 Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund as provided in  
12 Section 3 of this act.

13           B. The Department of Public Safety or motor license agents may  
14 inquire of each applicant, at the time of presentation of a  
15 completed application for an original or renewal driver license or  
16 identification card, whether the applicant is interested in making  
17 the contribution of Five Dollars (\$5.00) prescribed in subsection A  
18 of this section.

19           C. The incremental cost of administration of contributions to  
20 the fund, not to exceed one percent (1%) of the monies received  
21 pursuant to the provisions of this section, shall be paid by the  
22 fund to the Department of Public Safety from amounts received  
23 pursuant to the provisions of this section before funds are expended  
24 for the purposes of the fund.

1 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-125 of Title 47, unless there  
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
5 fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the  
6 "Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Revolving Fund". The fund shall  
7 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and  
8 shall consist of all monies received by the Department of Public  
9 Safety from:

10 1. Any state monies appropriated for the purpose of  
11 implementing the provisions of the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness  
12 Act; and

13 2. Any monies collected pursuant to this section or any other  
14 monies available to the Department of Public Safety to implement the  
15 provisions of the Oklahoma Bicycle Safety Awareness Act.

16 B. All monies credited to the fund are hereby appropriated and  
17 shall be budgeted and expended to provide awareness to the road  
18 traveling public of the presence of bicyclists by any media  
19 promotions, publications or signage.

20 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.

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
