8 An Act relating to elections; prohibiting certain  
9 officials from receiving certain compensation;  
10 providing for codification; and declaring an  
11 emergency.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-102.1 of Title 26, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any elected official that files a declaration of candidacy  
17 pursuant to Section 5-102 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall  
18 not receive compensation for the current elected position after a  
19 period of ten (10) days of the date the declaration of candidacy was  
20 filed.

21 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
22 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
23

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take  
2 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
