8 An Act relating to crimes and punishments;
9 authorizing United States Attorneys and Assistant
10 United States Attorneys to carry firearm under
11 certain circumstances; providing for codification;
12 and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.28 of Title 21, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Any United States Attorney or Assistant United States Attorney
18 may carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the State of
19 Oklahoma if the person has successfully completed an approved course
20 of firearm training conducted by a certified firearms instructor
21 which is equal to the minimum requirements for firearms training as
22 set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.
