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7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

8 An Act relating to Oklahoma historical societies;
9 requiring the Will Rogers Memorial Commission and the
10 J.M. Davis Memorial Commission to secure a certain
11 amount of funding from certain sources by certain
12 fiscal years; stating use and purpose of funding;
13 stating legislative intent; providing for
14 codification; providing an effective date; and
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 47.10 of Title 53, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Will Rogers Memorial Commission shall secure from
21 admission fees, proceeds from the sale of any materials and items,
22 payments received pursuant to a lease or gifts, grants,
23 contributions, or donations from any person, firm, corporation,
24 group of persons, governmental source or a municipality or other

1 political subdivision of this state an amount of funds that is equal
2 to or exceeds the following percentages of funding:

3 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, at least fifteen
4 percent (15%) of the total amount appropriated to the Commission for
5 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

6 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, at least thirty
7 percent (30%) of the total amount appropriated to the Commission for
8 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

9 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, at least forty-
10 five percent (45%) of the total amount appropriated to the
11 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

12 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, at least sixty
13 percent (60%) of the total amount appropriated to the Commission for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

15 5. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, at least seventy-
16 five percent (75%) of the total amount appropriated to the
17 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011; and

18 6. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, and for each
19 fiscal year thereafter, at least ninety percent (90%) of the total
20 amount appropriated to the Commission for the fiscal year ending
21 June 30, 2011.

22 B. The funds from sources as described in subsection A of this
23 section shall be used for the purpose of supplanting the amount
24 appropriated to the Commission by the Legislature for the operation

1 and maintenance of the Will Rogers Memorial and the Will Rogers
2 Homesite.

3 C. It is the intent of the Legislature to reduce the amount
4 appropriated to the Commission each fiscal year by an amount equal
5 to the amount secured by the Commission as required pursuant to this
6 section.

7 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 201H of Title 53, unless there
9 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 A. The J.M. Davis Memorial Commission shall secure from fees,
11 proceeds from the sale of any materials and items, payments received
12 pursuant to a lease or gifts, grants, contributions, or donations
13 from any person, firm, corporation, group of persons, governmental
14 source or a municipality or other political subdivision of this
15 state an amount of funds that is equal to or exceeds the following
16 percentages of funding:

17 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012, at least fifteen
18 percent (15%) of the total amount appropriated to the Commission for
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

20 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013, at least thirty
21 percent (30%) of the total amount appropriated to the Commission for
22 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

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1 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014, at least forty-
2 five percent (45%) of the total amount appropriated to the
3 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

4 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2015, at least sixty
5 percent (60%) of the total amount appropriated to the Commission for
6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011;

7 5. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, at least seventy-
8 five percent (75%) of the total amount appropriated to the
9 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011; and

10 6. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, and for each
11 fiscal year thereafter, at least ninety percent (90%) of the total
12 amount appropriated to the Commission for the fiscal year ending
13 June 30, 2011.

14 B. The funds from sources as described in subsection A of this
15 section shall be used for the purpose of supplanting the amount
16 appropriated to the Commission by the Legislature for the operation
17 and maintenance of the J.M. Davis Gun Collection and the J.M. Davis
18 Arms and Historical Museum.

19 C. It is the intent of the Legislature to reduce the amount
20 appropriated to the Commission each fiscal year by an amount equal
21 to the amount secured by the Commission as required pursuant to this
22 section.

23 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2011.
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1 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
