SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

An Act relating to schools; requiring qualified examiner to name and identify learning disorder; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.197 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

If a student is evaluated and is determined to have a learning disorder, the qualified examiner shall be required to specifically name and identify the disorder.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
