8 An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
9 allowing Oklahoma Turnpike Authority to incur certain
10 utility line expenses; defining term; providing for
11 codification; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1736 of Title 69, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 For qualified education utility line projects requiring locating
18 utility lines under a turnpike the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority may
19 upon approval of the Authority by a majority vote incur all or a
20 portion of the cost of locating the utility lines under the
21 turnpike. As used in this section, "qualified education utility
22 line project" means a project that is funded in whole or in part by
23 a general obligation bond issued by a school district after the vote
24

1 approval required by Section 26 of Article X of the Oklahoma
2 Constitution.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
