7 SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

8 An Act relating to state government; requiring  
9 specified agencies to share information and  
10 coordinate investigative and enforcement efforts for  
11 certain purpose; authorization for creation of secure  
12 database and promulgation of rules; providing for  
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8152 of Title 74, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The Oklahoma Tax Commission, Oklahoma Workers' Compensation  
19 Court, Department of Labor and Oklahoma Employment Security  
20 Commission shall share information and coordinate investigative and  
21 enforcement efforts for the purpose of detecting those employers who  
22 intentionally misclassify individuals as independent contractors  
23 rather than employees for the purpose of affecting procedures and  
24 payments relating to withholding and social security, unemployment  
25 tax or workers' compensation premiums. The agencies required by

1 this section to share information and coordinate efforts shall be  
2 authorized to create a secure database of information accessible by  
3 agency representatives responsible for enforcement and shall be  
4 further authorized to enter into contracts and interagency  
5 agreements and promulgate such rules as may be necessary to  
6 implement this section.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
