8 An Act relating to public health and safety;  
9 preventing individuals from receiving liver  
10 transplant if tobacco products are used during  
11 certain time; providing for codification; and  
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-2606 of Title 63, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 An individual shall be ineligible to receive a liver transplant  
18 in the State of Oklahoma if tobacco products are used for a six-  
19 month period prior to the scheduled transplant.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
