8 An Act relating to children; authorizing prosecution  
9 of certain Department of Human Services employees for  
10 certain violations; specifying requirements;  
11 providing for punishment; prohibiting certain  
12 benefits; providing for codification; and providing  
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-8-110 of Title 10A, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Any child welfare worker, child welfare supervisor or other  
19 employee of the Department of Human Services who knowingly and  
20 intentionally falsifies any document in a deprived child proceeding  
21 that results in the great bodily injury to or death of a child,  
22 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine  
23 of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment in the  
24

1 custody of the Department of Corrections for up to two (2) years or  
2 by both such fine and imprisonment.

3 B. Any employee of the Department of Human Services who is  
4 convicted pursuant to this section shall forfeit any retirement or  
5 other benefits accrued pursuant to Section 24.1 of Title 51 of the  
6 Oklahoma Statutes.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
