8 An Act relating to memorial highway designations;
9 designating the U.S. Border Patrol Chief Donald R.
10 Coppock Memorial Highway; designating the Coach Ray
11 Troutt Memorial Highway; designating the Senator
12 David Myers Memorial Highway; designating the Veldo
13 M. Goins Memorial Bridge; designating the Paul Harvey
14 Memorial Expressway; designating the Representative
15 Rusty Farley Memorial Highway; designating the Wesley
16 and Maxine Nixon Bridge; designating the Charles
17 Davis Memorial Highway; providing for codification;
18 and declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The portion of State Highway 11 from the junction of State
24 Highway 11 and U.S. Highway 64 extending east to the junction of
State Highway 11 and State Highway 38 shall be designated as the
"U.S. Border Patrol Chief Donald R. Coppock Memorial Highway".

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The portion of State Highway 58 from the junction of State
7 Highway 58 and State Highway 45 extending north to the junction of
8 State Highway 58 and U.S. Highway 64 shall be designated as the
9 "Coach Ray Troutt Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
10 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
11 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
12 bearing that name.

13 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The portion of State Highway 11 from the junction of State
17 Highway 11 and U.S. Highway 77 extending east to Kaw City, Oklahoma,
18 shall be designated as the "Senator David Myers Memorial Highway".
19 Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
20 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
21 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

22 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.115 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge crossing Grand Lake on U.S. Highway 59 in Delaware
2 County between Copeland, Oklahoma, and Grove, Oklahoma, shall be
3 designated as the "Veldo M. Goins Memorial Bridge". The Department
4 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
5 placed at the north and south ends of the bridge.

6 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.116 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The portion of U.S. Highway 75 from the junction of U.S. Highway
10 75 and U.S. Highway 412 extending south to the junction of U.S.
11 Highway 75 and U.S. Highway 64 shall be designated as the "Paul
12 Harvey Memorial Expressway". Pursuant to the provisions of Title 69
13 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation shall
14 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
15 bearing that name.

16 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.117 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The portion of U.S. Highway 70 from Broken Bow, Oklahoma,
20 extending south to Idabel, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
21 "Representative Rusty Farley Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the
22 provisions of Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of
23 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
24 upon the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.118 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge crossing State Highway 50 north of Freedom, Oklahoma,
5 near the intersection of State Highway 50 and U.S. Highway 64 shall
6 be designated as the "Wesley and Maxine Nixon Bridge". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 to be placed at the north and south ends of the bridge.

9 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.119 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The portion of State Highway 125 from the junction of State
13 Highway 125 and State Highway 85A extending south to where State
14 Highway 125 terminates on Monkey island shall be designated as the
15 "Charles Davis Memorial Highway". Pursuant to the provisions of
16 Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Department of Transportation
17 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway
18 bearing that name.

19 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take
22 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
