10 An Act relating to school district treasurer and
11 encumbrance clerks; amending Section 1, Chapter 472,
12 O.S.L. 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 5-190),
13 which relates to required instruction and continuing
14 education; exempting county treasurers acting in
15 certain capacity from certain instruction and
16 continuing education requirements; and providing an
17 effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 472, O.S.L.
20 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 5-190), is amended to read as
21 follows:

22 Section 5-190. A. Before July 1, 2007, every school district
23 treasurer shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction
24 on school finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the
duties and responsibilities of a school district treasurer.

1 B. Before July 1, 2007, every school district encumbrance clerk
2 shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction on school
3 finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the duties and
4 responsibilities of a school district encumbrance clerk.

5 C. Every school district treasurer and encumbrance clerk
6 employed after July 1, 2007, shall be required, within nine (9)
7 months after employment in the position by a school district, to
8 complete the instruction required pursuant to subsections A and B of
9 this section.

10 D. Every school district treasurer and encumbrance clerk shall
11 be required to complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours of continuing
12 education every three (3) years, in addition to the requirements of
13 subsections A and B of this section.

14 The requirements of this section shall not apply to any county
15 treasurer who also acts as a school district treasurer; however,
16 nothing herein shall prevent a county treasurer from attending such
17 training or continuing education.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
