9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An act relating to state agency attorneys;
11 authorizing state agency attorneys to serve as
12 special assistant district attorneys or special
13 assistant attorneys general upon appointment by
14 certain officials; providing for codification; and
15 declaring an emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 215.16A of Title 19, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A district attorney, upon approval of the executive director or
21 chair of the governing body of a state agency, may appoint any
22 attorney that is a full-time state employee to serve on a case-by-
23 case basis as a special assistant district attorney in a case in

1 which the expertise of the agency attorney would be of assistance to
2 the district attorney.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 28c.1 of Title 74, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The Attorney General, upon approval of the executive director or
7 chair of the governing board of a state agency, may appoint any
8 attorney that is a full-time state employee to serve on a case-by-
9 case basis as a special assistant attorney general in a case in
10 which the state is a party and the expertise of the agency attorney
11 would be of assistance to the Attorney General.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
