10 An Act relating to dedication of memorial highway;
11 designating the Sergeant Schuyler B. Patch Memorial
12 Highway; designating the Specialist Andrew R. Looney
13 Memorial Highway; designating the Specialist
14 Christopher D. Horton Memorial Highway; designating
15 the Sgt. Anthony Del Mar Peterson Memorial Highway;
16 designating the Captain John Thompson Memorial
17 Highway; designating the Barbara S. Swineford
18 Highway; designating the Merle D. Swineford Highway;
19 requiring certain permanent markers; providing for
20 codification; providing an effective date; and
21 declaring an emergency.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 86th Street North to 96th
Street North shall be designated as "Sergeant Schuyler B. Patch

1 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
2 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
3 name.

4 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 96th Street North to 106th
8 Street North shall be designated as "Specialist Andrew R. Looney
9 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause
10 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that
11 name.

12 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 106th Street North to 116th
16 Street North shall be designated as "Specialist Christopher D.
17 Horton Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
18 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
19 that name.

20 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.115 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of U.S. Highway 169 from 76th Street North to 86th
24 Street North shall be designated as the "Sgt. Anthony Del Mar

1 Peterson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
2 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
3 that name.

4 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.116 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of U.S. Highway 64 from Hooker, Oklahoma, extending
8 east to Turpin, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Captain John
9 Thompson Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
10 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
11 that name.

12 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.117 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of U.S. Highway 283 from Laverne, Oklahoma,
16 extending north to the intersection of U.S. Highway 283 and U.S.
17 Highway 64 shall be designated as the "Barbara S. Swineford
18 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
19 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

20 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.118 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of U.S. Highway 283 from Laverne, Oklahoma,
24 extending south to the intersection of U.S. Highway 283 and U.S.

1 Highway 412 shall be designated as the "Merle D. Swineford Highway".
2 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
3 markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

4 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

5 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
7 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
