10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
11 Investigation; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.6a,  
12 which relates to the annual salaries of employees of  
13 the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; deleting  
14 obsolete language; deleting reference to salary of  
the Director; authorizing the Director of the  
Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to modify  
salaries of certain employees; providing an effective  
date; and declaring an emergency.

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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.6a, is  
19 amended to read as follows:

20 Section 150.6a A. ~~Effective July 1, 2004, the annual salaries~~

3 criminalist job families may receive additional compensation through  
4 the use of pay mechanisms provided for in the Oklahoma Personnel Act  
5 and the Merit System of Personnel Administration Rules.

6           ~~C.~~ B. Effective ~~January~~ July 1, ~~2007~~ 2012, the annual salaries  
7 for the Deputy Director, and the positions within the Oklahoma State  
8 Bureau of Investigation, as set out in this section, shall be in  
9 accordance and conformity with the following salary schedule,  
10 exclusive of longevity pay as authorized by Section 840-2.18 of this

17            Provided, however, no such employee shall receive less than the  
18 salary the employee received on December 31, 2006.

19            SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

20            SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
