9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making it
11 unlawful to cut or damage a fence used for certain
12 purposes; providing penalties; providing for
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1791 of Title 21, unless there
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 Any person who, without good cause, maliciously and knowingly
20 cuts or damages a fence used for the production or containment of
21 cattle, bison, horses, sheep, swine, goats, domestic fowl, exotic
22 livestock, exotic poultry or any game animals or domesticated game
23 such that there is a loss or damage to the property is guilty of a
24 misdemeanor. Any person convicted of a second or subsequent offense

1 pursuant to this section, shall be guilty of a felony punishable by
2 a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by
3 imprisonment in the State Penitentiary not exceeding two (2) years,
4 or by both such fine and imprisonment.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
