10 An Act relating to homemade amusement rides; creating
11 a task force; stating purpose; providing for
12 appointment of membership, term, quorum and vacancy;
13 designating chair; providing for vice-chair;
14 requiring certain report by certain date; and
15 providing for noncodification.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
18 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

19 A. A task force is hereby created to review the operation and
20 inspection of homemade amusement rides. For purposes of this
21 section, "homemade amusement ride" means any self-designed and
22 constructed moving, mechanical or motorized device or combination of
23 devices or elements that carry, convey, transport or direct a person
24 or persons on a course or into, around, through or over water, ice,

1 air or terrain, for amusement or entertainment and which device or
2 elements of the device uses a power source, which may include, but
3 is not limited to, a motor vehicle, all-terrain vehicle, motorcycle,
4 lawn mower, tractor, airplane, electric or gasoline motor, or
5 mechanical or self-propelled action, to accomplish movement.

6 B. The task force shall consist of nine (9) members. Four
7 members shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
8 Senate. Four members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House
9 of Representatives. One member shall be appointed by the Governor.
10 Each member shall serve a term until January 1, 2012. A quorum
11 shall be five members and each member shall have one vote. Any
12 vacancy in membership shall be filled for the unexpired term by the
13 appointing authority.

14 C. The task force shall be chaired by the Governor's appointee
15 and a vice-chair may be selected by the majority of the appointed
16 members. The task force shall report its findings to the President
17 Pro Tempore of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
18 Representatives, and the Governor not later than January 1, 2012.
