10 An Act relating to the Joint Legislative Task Force
11 on the Grand River Dam Authority; amending Section 3,
12 Chapter 192, O.S.L. 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section
13 863.3), which relates to the task force; modifying
14 membership of the task force; requiring certain
15 biennial meetings; authorizing additional meetings;
16 requiring certain annual report to the task force;
17 prohibiting travel reimbursement; terminating
18 membership of certain task force members; requiring
19 appointment of new members by certain date; providing
20 for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 192, O.S.L.
23 2007 (82 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 863.3), is amended to read as
24 follows:

Section 863.3 A. There is hereby created the Joint Legislative
Task Force on the Grand River Dam Authority for the purpose of
studying the functions, activities, policies, procedures and

1 expenditures performed by the district and any related issues the
2 task force deems appropriate. Members of the task force shall be
3 appointed in January of each year following a state general election
4 by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the
5 House of Representatives. Membership shall be made up of ~~all Senate~~
6 ~~and House members whose legislative districts include a portion of~~
7 ~~the Grand River Dam Authority district~~ five members of the Senate
8 and five members of the House of Representatives whose legislative
9 districts include a portion of the Grand River Dam Authority
10 district to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate
11 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, respectively;
12 provided, one member shall be the House principal author of Senate
13 Bill No. 60 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature and
14 one member shall be the Senate principal author of Senate Bil No. 60
15 of the 1st Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature as long as these
16 individuals are members of the Legislature. The President Pro
17 Tempore and Speaker shall each designate one of their members to be
18 cochairs of the task force. The task force shall be required to
19 meet at least once biennially during the first session of each new
20 legislature. Additional meetings may be called as the cochairs
21 determine necessary. Meetings of the task force shall be called by
22 the cochairs. A majority of the appointed members shall constitute
23 a quorum for any meeting of the task force. Staffing assistance

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1 shall be provided by the staff of the Senate and House of
2 Representatives.

3 B. The members of the task force created herein shall continue
4 to serve until new members are appointed pursuant to the provisions
5 of subsection A of this section. ~~Such~~ The task force is authorized
6 to adopt any recommendations or issue any report it deems necessary.
7 Any recommendations or reports shall be approved by a majority of
8 the appointed members. Copies of any recommendations or reports
9 issued by the task force shall be distributed to the Governor, the
10 President Pro Tempore of the Senate ~~and~~, the Speaker of the House of
11 Representatives, the members of the Grand River Dam Authority Board
12 of Directors and the General Manager of the Grand River Dam
13 Authority.

14 C. The Grand River Dam Authority shall annually provide a copy
15 of the district's most recent annual report to the members of the
16 task force in addition to any information requested pursuant to the
17 provisions of this section.

18 D. Members serving on ~~this~~ the task force shall not be entitled
19 to travel reimbursement ~~as provided by Section 456 of Title 74 of~~
20 ~~the Oklahoma Statutes.~~

21 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
22 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

23 Members serving on the Joint Legislative Task Force on the Grand
24 River Dam Authority appointed prior to the effective date of this

1 act are hereby terminated. Appointments of new members made
2 pursuant to Section 863.3 of Title 82 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall
3 be made within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act.
4 Future appointments of task force members shall be made in January
5 of each year following a state general election.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
