17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 212B of Title 74, unless there
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 Copies of any audit, performance audit, agreed-upon-procedure
22 report, or other attestation engagement report produced by a person
23 other than the State Auditor and Inspector that is required to be
24 filed with the State Auditor and Inspector pursuant to Section 212A

1 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be submitted in
2 electronic, read-only format. The State Auditor and Inspector shall
3 make such reports available to the public at no charge on the State
4 Auditor and Inspector's website.

5 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 75 O.S. 2001, Section 14, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Section 14. A. The following officers shall be entitled to
8 receive as soon as available from the state without cost electronic
9 or digital copies of the ~~printed volumes of the~~ statutes and session
10 laws of the state published or purchased by the Legislature, or
11 under its authority, for distribution:

12 1. Each state officer, including the Governor and Lieutenant
13 Governor, the chief administrative officers and assistants of state
14 departments, boards, and commissions, upon written application and
15 request submitted to the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma
16 House of Representatives, within sixty (60) days of January 1 of
17 each year, and said volumes shall be distributed at the discretion
18 of the Chief Clerk-Administrator of the Oklahoma House of
19 Representatives; ~~and~~

20 2. Each member of the Legislature; ~~and~~

21 3. The Justices of the Supreme Court and the Judges of the
22 Court of Criminal Appeals, and the clerk of said Courts; ~~and~~

23 4. The chief administrative officers of the state educational,
24 benevolent, and penal institutions; ~~and~~

- 1 5. The judges of the district courts and district court clerks;
2 ~~and~~
3 6. County clerks; ~~and~~
4 7. County treasurers; ~~and~~
5 8. County assessors; ~~and~~
6 9. District attorneys and one assistant district attorney in
7 each county; ~~and~~
8 10. Sheriffs; ~~and~~
9 11. All members of the Oklahoma Congressional Delegation; and
10 12. Each library association organized in any county, city, or
11 town in this state for the benefit of the public.

12 B. Fifty-five (55) electronic or digital copies of the statutes
13 and session laws shall be furnished to the law library of the
14 College of Law of the University of Oklahoma, five copies to be kept
15 for use therein and fifty copies for purposes of exchange.

16 C. Five (5) electronic or digital copies of the statutes and
17 session laws shall be placed in the library of Oklahoma State
18 University at Stillwater, Oklahoma, for use therein.

19 D. ~~One hundred ten (110)~~ Sixty (60) electronic or digital
20 copies of the statutes and session laws shall be furnished to the
21 Oklahoma Department of Libraries for its use and exchange purposes
22 or, if the statutes and session laws are made available to the
23 Oklahoma Department of Libraries via the Internet, login information
24 for access to the statutes and session laws shall be furnished to

1 the Department of Libraries to enable the downloading of sixty (60)
2 licensed copies for the Department's use and exchange purposes.

3 E. The Chief Clerk-Administrator may, ~~in his discretion,~~
4 furnish ~~from any~~ digital or electronic copies of such laws ~~on hand~~
5 to state officers other than those specified in this section for the
6 use of their offices.

7 F. Any person or entity entitled to receive digital or
8 electronic copies of statutes or session laws as provided in this
9 section may request printed copies in lieu of such digital or
10 electronic copies.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
