9 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to information systems; prohibiting
11 ownership or leasing of certain information systems;
12 providing certain exceptions; repealing Section 1,
13 Chapter 507, O.S.L. 2004, as amended by Section 13,
14 Chapter 178, O.S.L. 2009 (57 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section
15 508.2c), which relates to the Oklahoma Integrated
16 Justice Information Systems Steering Committee;
17 providing for codification; and declaring an
18 emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.13.1 of Title 62, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, with the exceptions
24 of the Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance,
and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, no state entity shall own,
lease, or lease-purchase any telecommunications fiber networks used

1 for conveying electronic communication or information systems data
2 to multiple physical locations. All state-owned
3 telecommunications fiber networks are hereby transferred to the
4 Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance. This
5 transfer shall include all contracts for telecommunications fiber
6 networks, but shall not include assets used by the Oklahoma Turnpike
7 Authority as security for the issuance of bonds.

8 SECTION 2. REPEALER Section 1, Chapter 507, O.S.L. 2004,
9 as amended by Section 13, Chapter 178, O.S.L. 2009 (57 O.S. Supp.
10 2010, Section 508.2c), is hereby repealed.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
