10 An Act relating to investigations; amending 74 O.S.
11 2011, Section 360.17, as amended by Section 3 of
12 Enrolled Senate Bill No. 284 of the 2nd Session of
13 the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, which relates to
14 jurisdiction of campus police officers; requiring
15 notice to district attorney for certain crimes;
16 requiring notice of completion of investigation; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 360.17, as
20 amended by Section 3 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 284 of the 2nd
21 Session of the 53rd Oklahoma Legislature, is amended to read as
22 follows:

23 Section 360.17. A. The jurisdiction of campus police officers
24 includes the campus and pursuant to an agreement authorized by
Section 360.15 et seq. of this title, the highways, streets, roads,
alleys, easements, and other public ways immediately adjacent to

1 their campus and any other areas authorized by such agreement. This
2 delineation of jurisdiction, however, shall not be understood as
3 limiting the completion of any necessary enforcement activities
4 which began within these jurisdictions and are in compliance with
5 the agreements made with the municipality or county sheriff pursuant
6 to Section 360.15 et seq. of this title. In the absence of an
7 agreement, only those law enforcement activities which began on
8 campus may be completed off campus and such activities must be
9 completed in a timely manner. Such law enforcement activities shall
10 only be authorized if the campus police have coordinated the
11 activities with the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction
12 in that off campus area. In addition, a campus police officer shall
13 have jurisdiction in other locations pursuant to an agreement
14 authorized by Section 360.15 et seq. of this title. Such agreement
15 may authorize the chief administrative officer of the law
16 enforcement agency to request assistance pursuant to the agreement.
17 Campus police officers, commissioned pursuant to Section 360.15 et
18 seq. of this title, shall have the same powers, liabilities, and
19 immunities as sheriffs or police officers within their jurisdiction.

20 B. As limited by law, the provisions of this section, and the
21 governing board, a CLEET certified campus police officer shall have
22 the authority to enforce:

23 1. State criminal statutes;

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1 2. Municipal ordinances, if authorized by an agreement with the
2 municipality; and

3 3. Rules and regulations of the school, institution of higher
4 education or airport public trust or its beneficiary employing such
5 campus police officer.

6 C. As limited by law, the provisions of this section, and the
7 governing board, the campus police department shall have the same
8 authority as a municipal police department.

9 D. Campus police departments formed by private institutions of
10 higher education pursuant to Section 360.15 et seq. of this title
11 shall be deemed to be public agencies in the State of Oklahoma for
12 the limited purposes of enforcing the criminal statutes of Oklahoma
13 and making agreements with local law enforcement agencies or
14 political subdivisions of the state pursuant to Section 360.15 et
15 seq. of this title, provided, that the trustees of airport public
16 trusts shall also be deemed to be a public agency of this state as
17 provided in Section 179 of Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

18 E. Upon the effective date of this act, all campus police
19 departments of this state shall notify the district attorney
20 situated in the county where the campus police department is located
21 of any complaint received by the campus police on any alleged crime
22 of rape or child abuse that is to have occurred within the
23 jurisdictional boundaries of the campus. Such notice shall be
24 submitted within three (3) days of receiving the complaint. Upon

1 completion of the investigation of the complaint, the campus police
2 shall notify the district attorney of the results of the
3 investigation and whether or not the complaint is going to be
4 prosecuted pursuant to Section 360.21 of this title or if the
5 complaint was closed without prosecution.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.

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
