11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1134.4 of Title 47, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. For each motor vehicle used for the purpose of transporting
16 cotton modules from the point of production to the first point of
17 delivery or cotton gin, the annual license fee shall be Sixty
18 Dollars (\$60.00). Fees collected pursuant to this section shall be
19 apportioned pursuant to Section 1104 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
20 Statutes.

21 B. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall design appropriate license
22 plates for all vehicles registered pursuant to this section. The
23 license plates shall be permanent in nature and shall be designed in
24 a manner as to remain with the vehicle for the duration of the

1 vehicle's life span or until the title is transferred or the vehicle
2 is no longer used for the purposes specified in subsection A of this
3 section.

4 C. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall provide for an annual
5 permit which shall be required for any motor vehicle used for the
6 purpose of transporting cotton modules which is registered or
7 licensed pursuant to the laws of another state but which operates in
8 the state of Oklahoma. The permit fee shall be Sixty Dollars
9 (\$60.00) and shall be apportioned pursuant to Section 1104 of Title
10 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The permit shall be carried by the
11 operator of the vehicle and shall be available for inspection by any
12 law enforcement officer. Application for the permit shall be
13 available from the Tax Commission or any motor license agent and the
14 permit process shall allow for the permit to be obtained either in
15 person, by mail or electronically.

16 D. Any person, firm or corporation subject to the provisions of
17 subsection C of this section who transports cotton modules without
18 the required permit shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon
19 conviction thereof shall be punished as follows:

20 1. For the first such violation, by a fine of Five Hundred
21 Dollars (\$500.00);

22 2. For the second such violation, by a fine of One Thousand
23 Dollars (\$1,000.00); and

1 3. For the third and subsequent violations, by a fine of not
2 less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) nor more than Five
3 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

4 E. A motor vehicle subject to the license requirement in this
5 section shall be exempt from the license required pursuant to
6 Section 1133 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2013.
