8 An Act relating to identity and eligibility of
9 candidates; requiring proof of identity and
10 eligibility to hold office for certain candidates;
11 requiring documents to be available for public
12 inspection; providing for codification; and providing
13 an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-111.2 of Title 26, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Each candidate required to file a Declaration of Candidacy
19 for any federal, state, county, municipal or judicial office, or for
20 the nomination of a recognized political party, in any general,
21 primary, or special election shall, at the time of filing the
22 Declaration of Candidacy, provide proof of identity and eligibility
23 to hold the office sought to the election board at which the
24 Declaration was filed.

1 B. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall promulgate
2 rules to specify the documentation required to provide proof of
3 eligibility to hold the office sought. The requirement to provide
4 proof of identity may be satisfied by production of a document
5 specified in Section 7-114 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

6 C. Copies of documents provided pursuant to the provisions of
7 this section shall be made by the election board and kept available
8 for public inspection pursuant to the Oklahoma Open Records Act.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
