7 An Act relating to state government; authorizing
8 Governor to appoint or replace certain positions;
9 providing exceptions; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8.1 of Title 74, unless there is
14 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 In addition to any appointments created by expiring terms or
16 vacancies provided by law, the Governor shall have the power,
17 subject to the confirmation by the Senate, to appoint and replace
18 any gubernatorial appointments on any board or commission. Nothing
19 in this section shall apply to any state agency. Nothing in this
20 section shall apply to gubernatorial appointments to any board or
21 commission if the appointment authority is provided for in the
22 Constitution.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
