8 An Act relating to amusements and sports; providing
9 limited malpractice protection for certain
10 physicians; providing for codification; providing an
11 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 623 of Title 3A, unless there is
16 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Any physician providing medical services at an amateur or
18 professional athletic event sanctioned pursuant to the Oklahoma
19 State Athletic Commission Act who is a ring official at the event
20 and renders or attempts to render emergency care to an injured
21 participant who is in need of immediate medical aid shall not be
22 liable for damages as a result of any acts or omissions except for
23 committing gross negligence or willful or wanton negligence in
24 rendering the emergency care.
