12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.28 of Title 21, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any United States Attorney or Assistant United States Attorney
17 may carry a firearm on his or her person anywhere in the State of
18 Oklahoma if the person has successfully completed an approved course
19 of firearm training conducted by a certified firearms instructor
20 which is equal to the minimum requirements for firearms training as
21 set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
