7 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
8 amending Section 1, Chapter 74, O.S.L. 2009, as
9 amended by Section 1, Chapter 247, O.S.L. 2010 (59
10 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 367.8), which relates to the
11 maintaining of emergency medication kits in certain
12 facilities; modifying pharmacies that may maintain
13 certain substances in emergency medication kits;
14 deleting certain definition; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 74, O.S.L.
18 2009, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 247, O.S.L. 2010 (59 O.S.
19 Supp. 2010, Section 367.8), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 367.8 A. A ~~long-term-care~~ pharmacy may maintain
21 controlled dangerous substances in an emergency medication kit used
22 at a facility. The controlled dangerous substances may be used only
23 for the emergency medication needs of a resident at the facility. A
24 ~~long-term-care~~ pharmacy may maintain drugs in an emergency
medication kit for any facility.

1 B. The State Board of Pharmacy shall promulgate rules relating
2 to emergency medication kits, including, but not limited to:

3 1. The amount and type of controlled dangerous substances that
4 may be maintained in an emergency medication kit;

5 2. Procedures regarding the use of drugs from an emergency
6 medication kit;

7 3. Recordkeeping requirements; and

8 4. Security requirements.

9 C. As used in this section+

10 ~~1. "Facility", "facility" means a facility as defined by the~~
11 ~~Nursing Home Care Act or an assisted living center as defined by the~~
12 ~~Continuum of Care and Assisted Living Act; and~~

13 ~~2. "Long term care pharmacy" means a licensed pharmacy which~~
14 ~~primarily provides pharmacy services to a facility.~~

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
