8 An Act relating to public health and safety; defining  
9 term; providing that all persons are created free and  
10 have inalienable rights; providing for  
11 nonapplicability; providing for codification; and  
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-726 of Title 63, unless there  
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. As used in this section only, "person" means a human being  
18 at all stages of human development of life, including the state of  
19 fertilization or conception, regardless of age, health, level of  
20 functioning, or condition of dependency.

21 B. All persons are created free and have inalienable rights.

22 C. This act shall not apply to in vitro fertilization.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
