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8 An Act relating to the Supreme Court; amending
9 Section 9, Chapter 443, O.S.L. 2004 (20 O.S. Supp.
10 2010, Section 1310.2), which relates to the State
11 Judicial Revolving Fund; providing authorization to
12 use funds for specified purposes; and deleting
13 certain transfer requirement.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 9, Chapter 443, O.S.L 2004
16 (20 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 1310.2), is amended to read as follows:

17 ~~A.~~ There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
18 fund for the Supreme Court to be designated the "State Judicial
19 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
20 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all receipts
21 designated for deposit thereto pursuant to law and monies
22 appropriated by the Legislature for deposit thereto. All monies
23 accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may
24 be budgeted by the Supreme Court as necessary to perform the duties

1 imposed upon ~~the district courts by law, and upon~~ the Supreme Court
2 ~~and, Court of Civil Appeals pursuant to Section 1310.1 of Title 20~~
3 ~~of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ and district courts by law. The
4 Administrative Director of the Courts, with the approval of the
5 Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, is authorized to use the amounts
6 deposited in the State Judicial Revolving Fund for any lawful
7 purpose including, but not limited to, payment of recurring and
8 nonrecurring administrative and operating expenses for the Supreme
9 Court and the district courts, subject to the ceilings established
10 in the annual appropriations to the Supreme Court and the district
11 courts. The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, or the
12 Administrative Director of the Courts acting at the direction of the
13 Chief Justice, shall determine the allocation of funds and
14 expenditures between or among the Supreme Court, Court of Civil
15 Appeals, and district courts. Expenditures from said fund shall be
16 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
17 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for
18 approval and payment. The Supreme Court is hereby authorized to
19 transfer funds from the State Judicial Revolving Fund to the
20 district courts for duties imposed by law.

21 ~~B. On the effective date of this act, the Director of State~~
22 ~~Finance shall transfer all unbudgeted funds from the State Judicial~~
23 ~~Fund to the State Judicial Revolving Fund.~~
