8 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
9 creating the Department of Public Safety Restricted
10 Revolving Fund; specifying type of fund;
11 appropriating monies credited to the fund for
12 specific purposes; requiring transfer of certain
13 funds; creating the Department of Public Safety
14 Patrol Academy Revolving Fund; specifying type of
15 fund; appropriating monies credited to the fund for
16 specific purposes; providing for the expenditure of
17 funds; providing for codification; providing
18 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-145 of Title 47, unless there
24 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
fund for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the
"Department of Public Safety Restricted Revolving Fund". The fund
shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations.

All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby

1 appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the Department of
2 Public Safety for the restricted purposes of the monies as
3 prescribed by law. Expenditures from said funds shall be made upon
4 warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as
5 prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for approval
6 and payment.

7 B. Any statutory references to the Department of Public Safety
8 Revolving Fund shall mean the Department of Public Safety Restricted
9 Revolving Fund, as provided for in this section, whenever the
10 expenditure of the monies is restricted by law.

11 C. The Department of Public Safety shall transfer all funds,
12 for which expenditure is restricted by law, from the Department of
13 Public Safety Revolving Fund to the Department of Public Safety
14 Restricted Revolving Fund.

15 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-146 of Title 47, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
19 for the Department of Public Safety, to be designated the
20 "Department of Public Safety Patrol Academy Revolving Fund". The
21 fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year
22 limitations. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are
23 hereby appropriated and shall be budgeted and expended by the
24 Department of Public Safety for the exclusive purpose of Oklahoma
