7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 53 O.S. 2011,
8 Section 231, which relates to the Oklahoma Music Hall
9 of Fame Board; re-creating the Board; and modifying
10 the termination date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 53 O.S. 2011, Section 231, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 231. A. There is hereby ~~created~~ re-created until July
15 1, ~~2012~~ 2013, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma
16 Sunset Law, a board to be designated as the "Oklahoma Music Hall of
17 Fame Board". The Board shall be composed of seven (7) members who
18 shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of
19 the Senate. Of the initial members appointed, two shall serve for
20 two (2) years, two shall serve for four (4) years, and three shall
21 serve for six (6) years as the Governor may direct. After the
22 initial appointment, all members shall serve six - year terms.
23 Selection of members shall be made from those individuals who have

1 shown a sincere desire to recognize Oklahoma's contribution to
2 music.

3 B. The Board shall elect a chair and vice-chair from among the
4 membership to serve for one (1) year. Members of the Board shall
5 not be compensated for their services, but each member shall be
6 entitled to reimbursement in accordance with the State Travel
7 Reimbursement Act for expenses incurred in attending Board meetings.
8 The Board shall meet quarterly and at such other times as its rules
9 may prescribe. A majority of the members appointed shall constitute
10 a quorum for transaction of business. The Board may appoint and fix
11 the salaries and duties of an executive secretary or director and
12 such staff as may be necessary for the performance of its duties,
13 purposes and functions.

14 C. It shall be the function and main purpose of the Board to
15 honor those, living or dead, who, by achievement or service, have
16 made outstanding and lasting contributions to music in Oklahoma or
17 elsewhere. The Board may adopt such rules as may be needed to carry
18 out its duties, purposes and functions. Also, it may conduct
19 surveys and polls and may appoint such committees and
20 representatives as it may determine necessary or desirable.

21 D. The Board shall be responsible for selecting a suitable site
22 and/or facility in Muskogee, Oklahoma, which shall be dedicated to
23 the research, archiving and display of Oklahoma's musical heritage
24 and the individuals contributing to such heritage.
