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7 An Act relating to animals; amending 4 O.S. 2011,
8 Sections 392, 393, 397 and 399, which relate to using
9 animals for scientific or educational activities;
10 transferring licensing duties from State Board of
11 Health to Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,
12 and Forestry; providing for transfer of certain
13 records; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 392, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 392. An institution requiring for the effective
18 carrying on of its scientific or educational activities the use of
19 live dogs and cats may apply to the ~~State Board of Health~~ Oklahoma
20 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry for a license to
21 obtain animals from the establishment maintained and operated by
22 public funds for the confinement, care and disposal of animals
23 seized by public authority, commonly called the "dog pound". If the
24 ~~State Board of Health~~ Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
Forestry finds that the institution, by reason of its ethical

1 standards, its personnel, its facilities and the uses it proposes to
2 make of animals is a fit and proper agency to receive a license, and
3 that the public interest would be served by the issuance of a
4 license to the institution, it shall issue a license to the
5 institution, subject to the restrictions and limitations hereinafter
6 provided.

7 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 393, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 Section 393. A license shall expire annually on June 30, but
10 may be renewed annually from year to year on application to the
11 ~~State Board of Health~~ Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
12 Forestry, and on compliance with the conditions required with
13 respect to the original issuance of the license.

14 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 397, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 397. The ~~State Board of Health~~ Oklahoma Department of
17 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, after notice and a reasonable
18 opportunity to defend, may revoke the license granted an institution
19 (1) if the institution has violated any provision of this act or any
20 rule or regulation promulgated by the ~~State Board of Health~~ Oklahoma
21 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry pursuant hereto; (2)
22 if the standards, personnel, facilities, practices or activities of
23 an institution are such that the continued exercise of the rights
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1 conferred by the license issued to the institution is not in the
2 public interest.

3 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 4 O.S. 2011, Section 399, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 Section 399. A. The ~~State Board of Health~~ Oklahoma Department
6 of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall have the power to adopt
7 such rules and regulations, not inconsistent with the laws of
8 Oklahoma, as it may deem necessary to carry into effect the
9 provisions of this act. The ~~Commissioner of Health~~ Secretary of
10 Agriculture shall have the right whenever it deems advisable to
11 inspect or investigate any institution to which it has granted a
12 license or which has applied for a license.

13 B. Effective November 1, 2012, all records maintained by the
14 State Board of Health for the purposes of licensing institutions
15 pursuant to Sections 391-402 of this title shall be transferred to
16 the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry.

17 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
