9 An Act relating to public health and safety; amending  
10 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1527, which relates to  
11 tobacco restriction preemption; modifying legislative  
12 intent; providing that modified intent does not allow  
13 governmental subdivisions to adopt and enforce  
14 certain ordinances; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-1527, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1-1527. The State Legislature by adopting ~~this act~~  
19 ~~intends~~ the Smoking in Public Places and Indoor Workplaces Act does  
20 not intend to preempt any other regulation promulgated to control  
21 smoking in public places and intends to ~~standardize laws that permit~~  
22 governmental subdivisions ~~may~~ to adopt local ordinances to further  
23 control smoking. ~~Cities and towns may enact and enforce laws~~  
24 ~~prohibiting and penalizing conduct under provisions of this act, but~~

1 the provisions of such laws ~~shall be the same as provided in this~~  
2 ~~act and the enforcement provisions under such laws shall not~~ may be  
3 ~~more~~ less stringent or more stringent than those of ~~this act~~ the  
4 Smoking in Public Places and Indoor Workplaces Act.

5 This section shall not allow governmental subdivisions to adopt  
6 and enforce more stringent local ordinances than apply to private  
7 dining and social clubs.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
