7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.  
8 2011, Section 150.16, which relates to Oklahoma State  
9 Bureau of Investigation aircraft; authorizing  
10 ownership of additional aircraft; updating language;  
11 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.29, which relates  
12 to the petty cash fund of the Oklahoma State Bureau  
13 of Investigation; increasing petty cash fund amount;  
14 and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.16, is  
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 150.16 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation is  
19 hereby authorized to own and operate ~~one~~ aircraft and to rent or  
20 charter aircraft on a ~~project/mission~~ project or mission basis, such  
21 rental or charter to last only for the duration of the  
22 ~~project/mission~~ project or mission. The Bureau is also authorized  
23 to pay, from any funds available to the Bureau, expenses involved in  
24 qualifying multiengine and instrument pilots as may be required to  
accomplish agency responsibilities.

1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 150.29, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 Section 150.29 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation is  
4 hereby given authority to create a petty cash fund not to exceed ~~Two~~  
5 ~~Hundred Dollars (\$200.00)~~ Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) for each  
6 office of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, which may be  
7 expended for the purpose of providing change for cash payments for  
8 criminal history record checks and other Oklahoma Open Records Act  
9 search and copy fees.

10 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
