7 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68
8 O.S. 2011, Section 3006, which relates to the county
9 excise board; imposing continuing education
10 requirement; prescribing required credit hours;
11 providing for offering or approval of course content
12 by the Oklahoma State University Cooperative
13 Extension Service; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2011, Section 3006, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 3006. A. The county excise board shall meet at the
18 county seat on the first Monday of July of each year as provided in
19 Section ~~2494~~ 3014 of ~~Title 68~~ this title or on such earlier date in
20 the year as determined by the excise board, and organize by electing
21 one of its members as chairman, and another as vice chairman who
22 shall preside in the absence of the chairman, for the purpose of
23 performing the duties required of it by law during such fiscal year.
24 Thenceforth, said board may meet from day to day, or adjourn from
day to day and time to time thereafter for said purpose.

1 B. In its functionings it is hereby declared an agency of the
2 state, as a part of the system of checks and balances required by
3 the Constitution, and as such it is empowered to require adequate
4 and accurate reporting of finances and expenditures for all budget
5 and supplemental purposes, charged with the duty of requiring
6 adequate provision for performance of mandatory constitutional and
7 statutory governmental functions within the means available, but it
8 shall have no authority thereafter to deny any appropriation for a
9 lawful purpose if within the income and revenue provided.

10 C. Each member of the county excise board shall be required to
11 attend and successfully complete a course of instruction consisting
12 of at least six (6) hours within eighteen (18) months of appointment
13 for the first four (4) years of service on the board and three (3)
14 hours of instruction for every four (4) years of service after the
15 expiration of the initial four-year period. The course of
16 instruction shall include the duties and responsibilities of the
17 county excise board, including duties and responsibilities related
18 to authorized millage rates imposed by local taxing jurisdictions,
19 and the course shall be offered by or approved by the Oklahoma State
20 University Cooperative Extension Service.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
