A Concurrent Resolution supporting the hosting of a
Grand Prix race in Oklahoma City; and directing
distribution.

1 WHEREAS, Oklahoma City Motorsports wishes to bring premier
2 automobile racing to the State of Oklahoma and Oklahoma City's
3 Adventure District; and

4 WHEREAS, Oklahoma City Motorsports is requesting the support of
5 the State of Oklahoma, Oklahoma County and the City of Oklahoma
6 City, as well as securing the support of national, regional and
7 local corporate partners to host a Grand Prix race, the most
8 exciting sporting event in the world; and

9 WHEREAS, the Grand Prix race will attract as many as 100,000
10 spectators with many of those traveling to Oklahoma from other
11 states and other countries benefitting our tourism-based economy;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, Oklahoma will experience an estimated positive economic
14 impact of \$15 million to \$20 million from hosting the Grand Prix
15 Race Week; and

16 WHEREAS, Oklahoma will receive both national and international
17 exposure from the media coverage generated from this world-class
18 televised event; and

19 WHEREAS, the Grand Prix race and other special events planned
20 during race week will benefit some of Oklahoma's most popular
21 attractions located in Oklahoma City's Adventure District; and

22 WHEREAS, the inaugural Grand Prix race is planned for Oklahoma
23 City in 2013, and will be a premier sporting event for Oklahoma
24 City, Oklahoma County and the State of Oklahoma.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
2 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 53RD OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
3 CONCURRING THEREIN:

4 THAT a Grand Prix event would be of great economic benefit to
5 the Oklahoma City area and the entire state.

6 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature wholeheartedly supports Oklahoma
7 City hosting a Grand Prix racing event.

8 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Mayor of
9 Oklahoma City, the Oklahoma City Council and the Board of County
10 Commissioners of Oklahoma County.
