1 WHEREAS, the American Society for Public Administration and the
2 National Academy of Public Administration established the National
3 Public Service Awards in 1983 to honor individuals whose
4 accomplishments are models of public service within and outside the
5 work environment; and

6 WHEREAS, the National Public Service Award Program recognizes
7 individuals who exhibit the highest standards of excellence,
8 dedication, and accomplishment over a sustained period of time and
9 who are creative and skilled career managers across all sectors of
10 public service; and

11 WHEREAS, Lester Claravall, Child Labor Coordinator for the
12 Oklahoma Department of Labor is the recipient of the 2011 National
13 Public Service Award; and

14 WHEREAS, Lester Claravall created first-ever partnerships,
15 publications, and programs to increase protection of Oklahoma's
16 working minors. He led the charge to replace the antiquated paper
17 work permit system with an online work permit process and created
18 the national award-winning "Paying Attention Pays", whose game
19 format teaches students about workplace rights and has been shared
20 with more than 30 countries on four continents; and

21 WHEREAS, Lester Claravall, Oklahoma's only full-time Child Labor
22 Specialist responsible for all 77 counties, in an effort to protect
23 children from exploitation and endangerment created the state's
24 first ever door-to-door safety awareness poster and brochure to

1 educate parents and teens about illegal youth peddling. His written
2 contributions and feedback made to the National Young Worker Health
3 and Safety Network led to changes to the federal child labor laws.

6 CONCURRING THEREIN:

9 degree of dedication to service and professionalism.
