17 organizations, associations and government agencies with an interest
18 in fire service education at state and local levels;

19 5. Disseminate state-of-the-art materials concerning fire
20 service education to the membership;

2 and education programs and procedures, and analyze problems arising

4 8. Promote the importance of the role of the fire service
5 instructors in the total fire service organization; and
