10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 472, O.S.L.
12 2005 (70 O.S. Supp. 2010, Section 5-190), is amended to read as
13 follows:

14 Section 5-190. A. Before July 1, 2007, every school district
15 treasurer shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction
16 on school finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the
17 duties and responsibilities of a school district treasurer.

18 B. Before July 1, 2007, every school district encumbrance clerk
19 shall complete at least twelve (12) hours of instruction on school
20 finance laws of this state, accounting, ethics, and the duties and
21 responsibilities of a school district encumbrance clerk.

22 C. Every school district treasurer and encumbrance clerk
23 employed after July 1, 2007, shall be required, within nine (9)
24 months after employment in the position by a school district, to

1 complete the instruction required pursuant to subsections A and B of
2 this section.

3 D. Every school district treasurer and encumbrance clerk shall
4 be required to complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours of continuing
5 education every three (3) years, in addition to the requirements of
6 subsections A and B of this section.

7 The requirements of this section shall not apply to any county
8 treasurer who also acts as a school district treasurer; however,
9 nothing herein shall prevent a county treasurer from attending such
10 training or continuing education.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
