6 An Act relating to memorial bridge designations;
7 designating the Lt. Colonel Warren Pingleton Memorial
8 Bridge; designating the Major Bill Morgan Memorial
9 Bridge; designating the Ronnie Sumpter, Sonny Harris
and Rhonda Howard Memorial Bridge; requiring certain
markers; providing for codification; providing an
effective date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.112 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge over Brushy Creek on State Highway 63 southwest of
16 Haileyville shall be designated as the "Lt. Colonel Warren Pingleton
17 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the
19 bridge.

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.113 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge over Brushy Creek on United States Highway 270
24 northwest of Haileyville shall be designated as the "Major Bill

1 Morgan Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
2 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on
3 the bridge.

4 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.114 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge over the Little Fourche Maline Creek on State Highway
8 270 east of the municipal limits of Panola shall be designated as
9 the "Ronnie Sumpter, Sonny Harris and Rhonda Howard Memorial
10 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
11 permanent markers bearing those names to be placed on the bridge.

12 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.

13 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
