9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 215.16A of Title 19, unless
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A district attorney, upon approval of the executive director or
14 chair of the governing body of a state agency, may appoint any
15 attorney that is a full-time state employee to serve on a case-by-
16 case basis as a special assistant district attorney in a case in
17 which the expertise of the agency attorney would be of assistance to
18 the district attorney.

19 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 28c.1 of Title 74, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The Attorney General, upon approval of the executive director or
23 chair of the governing board of a state agency, may appoint any
24 attorney that is a full-time state employee to serve on a case-by-

1 case basis as a special assistant attorney general in a case in
2 which the state is a party and the expertise of the agency attorney
3 would be of assistance to the Attorney General.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
