8 An Act relating to personal identification; requiring  
9 the Department of Public Safety to provide space for  
10 certain emblem on driver licenses and identification  
11 cards; requiring presentation of certain documents;  
12 providing for codification; and providing an  
13 effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-124 of Title 47, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 As a way to honor and recognize the veterans who have served our  
19 country, the Department of Public Safety shall make space available  
20 on the front or back of the driver license and the identification  
21 card for a flag emblem to be designed by the Department that will  
22 serve as a notation of veteran status. Upon application for  
23 issuance or renewal of the driver license or identification card and  
24 in addition to other documentation required by the Department,

1 persons requesting the flag emblem shall show proof of present or  
2 past military service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services  
3 Identity Card or the United States Department of Defense Form  
4 (DD) 214.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2011.
