10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2010 of Title 56, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. The Department of Human Services shall:

15 1. In consultation with Oklahoma Health Care Authority,
16 evaluate all persons currently in the state Medicaid program who are
17 categorically eligible as aged, blind or disabled individuals to
18 determine if such persons are dually eligible for the Medicare
19 program; and

20 2. Evaluate all persons in the state who apply and qualify for
21 the state Medicaid program as an aged, blind, or disabled individual
22 to determine if such persons are dually eligible for the Medicare
23 program.
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1 B. If the Department determines that individuals are dually
2 eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare, the Department shall take
3 all necessary steps to assist such persons in enrolling in the
4 Medicare program in addition to the state Medicaid program.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.
