6 An Act relating to court clerks; amending 19 O.S.  
7 2011, Section 220, which relates to the Court Clerk's  
8 Revolving Fund; modifying methods of expenditure of  
9 certain monies; modifying entity to develop and  
implement certain forms and procedures; and providing  
an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2011, Section 220, is  
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 220. A. Beginning July 1, 1991, there is hereby  
14 created with the county treasurer of each county within this state a  
15 depository revolving fund to be designated the "Court Clerk's  
16 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject  
17 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received  
18 as grants from the federal government and any other monies  
19 designated by law for deposit into the fund. All monies accruing to  
20 the credit of the fund ~~are hereby appropriated and~~ shall be expended  
21 by the court clerk for the lawful operation of the court clerk's  
22 office. Claims against the fund shall include only expenses  
23 incurred for the operation of the court clerk's office in each  
24 county, and payment may be made after the claim is approved by the

1 court clerk and either the district or the associate district judge  
2 of that county. The monies shall be reported quarterly to the  
3 Administrator of the Courts. The necessary forms and procedures  
4 shall be developed and implemented by the ~~State Auditor and~~  
5 ~~Inspector~~ Administrative Office of the Courts.

6 B. There shall be no monies, other than federal funds,  
7 deposited into the fund created herein, unless expressly authorized  
8 by the Legislature.

9 C. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the court clerk  
10 shall assess an administrative fee of ten percent (10%) on all fees  
11 collected by the court clerk for agencies other than the court and  
12 not deposited into the court fund. The administrative fee shall not  
13 attach to the sheriff's service fees provided for in Sections 153  
14 and 153.2 of Title 28 of the Oklahoma Statutes, monies deposited  
15 into the Law Library Fund, witness fees paid by the district  
16 attorney pursuant to the provisions of Section 82 of Title 28 of the  
17 Oklahoma Statutes, and dispute resolution fees provided for in  
18 Section 1809 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes. The  
19 administrative fees shall be deposited in the Court Clerk's  
20 Revolving Fund.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2012.  
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
