6 [State Capitol - State Capitol Renovation and
7 Maintenance Revolving Fund - deposits and
8 expenditures - codification - effective date -
9 emergency]

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 4105, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 4105. A. There is hereby established the position of
14 the Capitol Architect and Curator who shall:

15 1. Develop the technical plans and programs for consideration
16 by the Legislature, the Governor and the State Capitol Preservation
17 Commission with regard to restoration, renovation, and preservation
18 of the Capitol and the Governor's Mansion; ~~and~~

19 2. Develop and enforce standards adopted for acquisition and
20 display of works of art in and surrounding the Capitol and the
21 Governor's Mansion; ~~and~~

22 3. Coordinate space demands of the various agencies in the
23 Capitol and the Governor's Mansion; ~~and~~

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1 4. Maintain a record of all structural and decor changes made
2 in the Capitol and the Governor's Mansion; and

3 5. Make recommendations to the Legislature, the Governor and
4 the Commission of necessary action on proposed modifications in
5 decor or design to ensure preservation and maintenance of the
6 cultural and historic integrity of the Capitol and the Governor's
7 Mansion.

8 The ~~Director of Public Affairs~~ may Legislative Service Bureau
9 shall contract for the services of a Capitol Architect and Curator
10 or employ such an individual on either a full- or part-time basis.
11 Compensation for the position will be in accord with similar
12 professional positions in state government.

13 B. In addition to the duties set forth in subsection A of this
14 section, it shall be the duty of the Capitol Architect and Curator
15 to develop a plan for renovation and reconstruction of the Capitol
16 to be completed in time for celebration of the 100th anniversary of
17 completion of the State Capitol Building in 2017. The Capitol
18 Architect and Curator shall consult with the Governor, the President
19 Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
20 Representatives or such members as may be designated thereby, and
21 with other tenants of the Capitol Building, to determine the needs
22 for and scope of renovation and reconstruction. The Capitol
23 Architect and Curator shall submit a plan to the Governor, the
24 President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives not later than December 31, 2012, which shall
2 include the estimated costs of and estimated schedule for renovation
3 and reconstruction.

4 C. The State Capitol Preservation Commission, the Division of
5 Central Services of the Office of State Finance and all tenants of
6 the Capitol Building are hereby directed to cooperate with and
7 provide such assistance to the Capitol Architect and Curator as may
8 be necessary.

9 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 452.16 of Title 74, unless there
11 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
13 for the Legislative Service Bureau to be designated the "State
14 Capitol Renovation and Maintenance Revolving Fund". The fund shall
15 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and
16 shall consist of all monies received by the Bureau from funds
17 designated for deposit thereto. All monies accruing to the credit
18 of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended
19 by the Bureau for the purpose of making expenditures related to
20 renovation and maintenance of the State Capitol. Expenditures from
21 the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer
22 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State
23 Finance for approval and payment.

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
