7 An Act relating to county officers salaries; amending
8 19 O.S. 2001, Sections 180.63, as amended by Section
9 1, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010, and 180.75, as amended
10 by Section 2, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010 (19 O.S. Supp.
11 2010, Sections 180.63 and 180.75), which relate to
12 the increases in the basic salaries of county
13 officers; making certain salary increases optional;
14 and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 180.63, as
17 amended by Section 1, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010 (19 O.S. Supp. 2010,
18 Section 180.63), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 180.63 In every county in this state, the salary of all
20 county officers named in paragraph 1 of Section 180.61 of this title
21 ~~shall~~ may be increased from the applicable basic salary named in
22 Section 180.62 of this title, for net valuation or serviceability,
23 according to the following scale:

24 A. To the basic salary:

1. Add the product of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) times
each One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) net

1 valuation, or major fraction thereof until a net
2 valuation of Seventy-five Million Dollars
3 (\$75,000,000.00) is reached;

4 2. Thereafter add the product of One Hundred Dollars
5 (\$100.00) times each additional Five Million Dollars
6 (\$5,000,000.00) net valuation, or major fraction
7 thereof until a net valuation of Five Hundred Million
8 Dollars (\$500,000,000.00) is reached;

9 3. Thereafter add the product of One Hundred Twenty-five
10 Dollars (\$125.00) times each additional Seven Million
11 Dollars (\$7,000,000.00) net valuation, or major
12 fraction thereof until a net valuation of Two Billion
13 Dollars (\$2,000,000,000.00) is reached;

14 4. Thereafter as to all additional net valuation add the
15 product of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00)
16 times each additional Twenty Million Dollars
17 (\$20,000,000.00) net valuation, or major fraction
18 thereof.

19 B. ~~And also~~ Also, the salary of each county officer shall be
20 additionally increased from the basic salary named in Section 180.62
21 of this title, and the additions thereto heretofore provided in this
22 section, for population or service load according to the following
23 scale:

- 1 1. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)
2 times each one thousand (1,000) population, or major
3 fraction thereof until a population of seventy-five
4 thousand (75,000) is reached; thereafter
- 5 2. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)
6 times each additional five thousand (5,000)
7 population, or major fraction thereof until a
8 population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) is
9 reached; thereafter add
- 10 3. The product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)
11 times each additional ten thousand (10,000)
12 population, or major fraction thereof.

13 C. This section shall not reduce the present salary of any
14 county officer in Oklahoma during their present term of office.

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 180.75, as
16 amended by Section 2, Chapter 362, O.S.L. 2010 (19 O.S. Supp. 2010,
17 Section 180.75), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 180.75 A. In every county in this state which approves
19 an exemption of household goods of the heads of families and
20 livestock employed in support of the family from ad valorem taxation
21 pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of Article X of the Oklahoma
22 Constitution, the salary of all county officers named in paragraph 1
23 of Section 180.73 of this title ~~shall~~ may be increased from the
24 applicable basic salary named in Section 180.74 of this title, for

1 the factor of service-ability, as defined in Section 180.71 of this
2 title, according to the following scale:

3 1. To the basic salary:

4 a. add the product of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) times
5 each Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) of revenue
6 authorized to be collected for county purposes, or
7 major fraction thereof until the amount of such
8 revenue equals Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars
9 (\$750,000.00),

10 b. thereafter add the product of One Hundred Dollars
11 (\$100.00) times each additional Fifty Thousand Dollars
12 (\$50,000.00) of revenue authorized to be collected for
13 county purposes, or major fraction thereof until the
14 amount of such revenue equals Five Million Dollars
15 (\$5,000,000.00),

16 c. thereafter add the product of One Hundred Twenty-five
17 Dollars (\$125.00) times each additional Seventy
18 Thousand Dollars (\$70,000.00) of revenue authorized to
19 be collected for county purposes, or major fraction
20 thereof until the amount of such revenue equals Twenty
21 Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00),

22 d. thereafter as to all additional revenue which is
23 authorized to be collected for county purposes add the
24 product of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00)

1 times each additional Two Hundred Thousand Dollars
2 (\$200,000.00) of such revenue, or major fraction
3 thereof; and

4 2. The salary of each county officer shall be additionally
5 increased from the basic salary named in Section 180.74 of this
6 title, and the additions to the basic salary as provided in this
7 section, for population or service load according to the following
8 scale:

9 a. the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50)
10 times each one thousand (1,000) population, or major
11 fraction thereof until a population of seventy-five
12 thousand (75,000) is reached,

13 b. thereafter the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty
14 cents (\$12.50) times each additional five thousand
15 (5,000) population, or major fraction thereof until a
16 population of one hundred fifty thousand (150,000) is
17 reached,

18 c. thereafter add the product of Twelve Dollars and fifty
19 cents (\$12.50) times each additional ten thousand
20 (10,000) population, or major fraction thereof.

21 B. This section shall not reduce the present salary of any
22 county officer in Oklahoma during their present term of office.

23 C. As used in this section, "major fraction thereof" means any
24 amount greater than one-half (1/2).
